

2. The Project Works

1 Contractor Mobilises 15th Sep – 01st Oct

- 1. Mobilise construction team
- 2. Procurement
- 3. Setup of compound



2. Construction Works 04th Oct – 09th Nov

- 1. Removal of 100mm asphalt
- 2. Apply asphalt reinforcement
- 3. Apply 100mm new asphalt to finished level



3. AGL and Markings 27th October 2021 - 09th November 2021


Due to extensive lead time for delivery of AGL equipment:

- 1. The runway will operate with the existing runway edge lights.
- 2. The existing APAPI's will be relocated to the reduced runway.
- 3. The Contractor will fit temporary blue lights on the reclassified taxiway.
- 4. Calibration test to be completed of APAPI's units.
- Installation of taxiway signage.
- 6. Runway markings
- 7. Update of AIP and NOTAM for temporary blue lights.



4. Handover /CAA Approval 10th November 2021

- Handover of Runway from Contractor to HIAL.
- 2. CAA inspection



5. Runway Operational 11th November 2021

- 1. Loganair to resume flights.
- 2. Air medical services to resume.



6. Final installation of AGL 05th Jan 2022 – 31st Jan 2022

- 1. Installation of runway edge lights
- 2. Removal of temporary blue lights
- 3. Installation of permanent taxiway blue lights



- 2. A83 under jurisdiction of Transport Scotland




Campbeltown Airport Road
